Richard Corrigan celebrates as his two London restaurants make the top 100

Hot on the heels of his award for AA London Restaurant of the year, the legendary Irish chef patron Richard Corrigan celebrated a double win at the National Restaurant of the Year Awards, held at the Hurlingham Club, west London on October 12th.
